3. MATTERS ARISING:

Bottle/Can Banks: As the village will not be getting the new three bin system of refuse collection and re-cycling until March 2005, it would be to our advantage to have the bottle/can banks returned if a suitable site could be found. This will be looked into.

Salt Bin: This is in the same position as previously, but it was also suggested that a bin be placed at the top of Kennedy Drive, too. Councillor Murray will pass on this request.

All Weather play area: Surface will cost in the region of £10,000. Money may be available from Community Enhancement Fund but the total cost may be in the region of over £40,000.

Path behind bus park has now been repaired.

"Gully Pot" in Station Road has now been repaired.

Butterfly Garden update: This area has now been sprayed to clear weeds and it is hoped it will be planted up by end of March. Fisherton School children have been asked to design signs for the Butterfly Garden.

Councillor Murray advised the entrance to the school playground will be altered with less of a slope.

A letter from Scottish Water to Mr Scott of Fisherton Avenue was circulated. The residents there are looking at ways to get their communal septic tank repaired.

Councillor Murray explained the rules governing the consumption of alcohol in the open. This may be consumed in any private area, but not in any built up and public areas of villages and towns in South Ayrshire.

Councillor Murray has had a request from a resident for a disabled parking area, which he has passed on to the appropriate department.

Councillor Murray advised a sum of £4,500 has been received by the Harbour Committee from the Rural Affairs Committee towards the cost of emergency repairs on breakwater.

The field at Fisherton backing onto Fisherton Avenue is still being considered for housing, but not in the immediate future.
