**Seaview:** New signs on order - awaiting their installation.

**Butterfly Garden** - A Guthrie now confident with the money available this area will be improved and proper signs erected.

**Equipment for Beach Clean:** A Guthrie to compile list of equipment needed and still hopeful finding funding will be available to repair old stables in park to house it. in

the short term perhaps suitable storage could be found at harbour. A Guthrie has to attend a Health & Safety Course in connection with this.

**A Guthrie** has had meetings re old stables in park - will need a bit of money to repair but should be able to get funding. Equipment for "litter cleaning" will be available.

**A Guthrie** having beach clean on 20 September and is asking for volunteers.

**Bottle/Can banks:** As there is now only one operator to remove these banks the site must be level and the area at bus park cannot be used as it is on a slope. If anyone has suggestions for an alternative site it would be considered. In the long term the Council hope to have household collections for recyclable items but it would be of benefit to have these bottle and can banks back in the village as they are well used.

**Maybole Path:** There have been complaints about the inadequacy of signs for this path.

**Cllr Murray** is attending official opening of Fisherton School Nursery at the beginning of October.

**Cllr Murray** had a letter from a resident asking about the possibility of parking bays in Kennedy Drive. Community Council appreciate parking is a problem, but no solution could be suggested.

**C Hayes** asked Cllr Murray about the key for the Castle over the Winter. It was agreed the Castle should be closed unless anyone specifically asks for access.
