Minutes of a Meeting held on Tuesday 17 February 2004 in the Kennedy Hall.

1. APOLOGIES: J Eaglesham, Cllr Alan Murray.

2. ADOPTION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES: Proposed by Steve Hudson. Seconded by Andrew Guthrie.

3. MATTERS ARISING:

Bottle/Can Banks: It has been agreed they will be positioned just inside the gates of Kennedy Park. This should be done by Friday 20 February.

Salt Bin: No-one is aware if an extra bin has been sited at top of Kennedy Drive.

All Weather play area: A meeting will be taking place in two weeks when a "way forward" document will be discussed.

Butterfly Garden update: A Guthrie reported further weed killer has been applied and some of the area turned over. On 6 March the fence will be erected and A Guthrie has asked for volunteers from the community to assist here. Drawings from Fisherton School children will be passed on. A Guthrie has to submit a list of plants suitable for this project.

Public Liability Insurance: South Ayrshire Council have now agreed to pay this insurance which will cover until end of March 2005.

North Fisherton Sewage: Details of repairs still being worked out.

New Village Hall: R Storie had original plans, which had been drawn up a few years ago, and were felt to be much too ambitious for a village hall.

Flooding on roads: This problem has been passed to drainage department.

Potholes: Some of these have been repaired again with a temporary fill which everyone agrees only lasts a very short time and seems to be throwing money away. A

Stewart advises the A719 should be resurfaced during the coming year if budget permits.

Litter: This seems to have been cleared from the ditches on Station Road.

Carrick Place - Overhanging Shrubs: Owners will be notified to have these cut back.

Web Site: This has been re-activated at a cost of £29 plus VAT. This site is called "www.dunure.info"

Bus Stop at Harbour: There is no option as to the siting of this as the area opposite the harbour is not big enough and there is a danger from falling rocks, and South Ayrshire Council do not wish to be responsible should there be an accident. This bus stop will be positioned 35 metres north east of the existing stop. All the Community Council members' felt this was too near the bend, as did the bus drivers and passengers who alight at this stop. A bus stop will also be created opposite the Heads of Ayr Caravan Park.
