Minutes of a Meeting held on Tuesday 16th March 2004 at 7.30pm in the Kennedy Hall.

1. APOLOGIES: P C Jim McGarry.

2. ADOPTION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES: Proposed by Roy Storie, seconded by Steve Hudson.

3. MATTERS ARISING:

Bottle/Can Banks: The Bins for re-cycling have been placed at the south end of the children's playpark in Kennedy Park. It was stressed no one from the council contacted Community Council members as to the siting of these bins. Kennedy Hall & Park Committee were not consulted about the bins, and feel it is only right they should be informed of any decisions regarding the Park. There is a concern about the bins being near the play area - broken glass, and wasps etc in the summer months, although everyone understands this is only temporary as the new kerb-side re-cycling will be in operation with a year.

Salt Bin: A bin has been sited at top of Kennedy Drive.

Butterfly Garden update: A Guthrie gave an update here. A fence has been erected and he has given a list of plants (numbers of each variety). A planting day will be arranged in due course.

New Village Hall: Nothing further to report here. R Storie commented B Baillie from South Ayrshire Council has been very helpful.

Flooding on roads: Nothing further to report here.

Potholes: Some re-surfacing may be done in the area over the summer months.

Litter: R Storie suggests the ditches in Station Road would benefit from being cleaned out as there is an accumulation of litter under old leaves.

Web Site: As time permits, P Hayes is upgrading the new site.

Bus Stop at Harbour: As all members are against the bus stop being moved nearer the bend in the road (north of the present position), Councillor Murray, A Guthrie, R Storie, will have a site visit to discuss this.

Graffiti: This has been applied to park attendant's hut and the road sign south of village. This is purported to have been persons from outwith the village. The Kennedy Hall & Park Committee is proposing to tackle said graffiti on the hut in park. Councillor Murray will pass on details to have the sign cleaned.
