Minutes of a Meeting held on Tuesday 16th November 2004 at 7.00pm in the Kennedy Hall.

1. APOLOGIES: Mrs Dympna Gardiner .

2. ADOPTION OF PREVIOUS MINUTES: Proposed by David Broadhead, Seconded A Guthrie.

3. MATTERS ARISING:

SCOTTISH WATER SOLUTIONS: There will be a meeting in Kennedy Hall on Monday 22 November at 7.30pm. There is still concern in the village regarding the proposed site of Pumping Station at Seaview, and this meeting has been called by Scottish Water to discuss their new proposals .

BUTTERFLY GARDEN: The signs have now been erected, and Mr Guthrie suggests a photograph of the children concerned might be appropriate .

4. POLICE REPORT: P C Hamil attended our meeting along with Sergeant William Gilmour. P C Hamil has made enquiries regarding speed limit on bottom stretch of Station Road, but as we already anticipated, this will not be considered as there are no houses or street lights on this part of the road. As Traffic Police are fully committed, it has been suggested if the Community Police can raise funds for a hand held camera they may be able to use this at more convenient times for speed related offences. One drugs related incident in the village (personal use), and a problem with "sand buggies" and "scooters" on Kennedy Drive and Arran View which is being addressed to try and prevent accidents. A Guthrie passed on a TETRA report to the police officers, as there is some concern that the use of this type of radio is detrimental to health. Sgt Gilmour will try to attend our meetings when possible.

5. COUNCILLOR'S REPORT: Councillor Murray asked to borrow the "Environmental Appraisal" in respect of the new Waste Water Treatment Plant. Mr Kenny Naylor, Scottish Water, has asked to meet with Councillor Murray on Friday. Has passed request for "both ways" bus stop at Fisherton School and something will

be done here. Also a safe dropping off stop at Heads of Ayr Caravan Park will be constructed. He has passed on request for railings at bottom of lane (Carrick Place/Kennedy Drive) and awaits reply to this.
