**PROPOSED CHANGE TO LOCAL PLAN:** At a meeting with South Ayrshire Council, NTS and Mr Gavin Morton, it was confirmed that as NTS had a legally binding agreement with landowners to preserve this area (west of A719 from Culzean to Heads of Ayr) the Council will not now release this land at Fisherton for the purpose of house building.
