1. APOLOGIES:

2. Adoption of minutes for meeting of Tuesday 16 September 2008.

3. POLICE REPORT:

No Police report to hand.

4. COUNCILLOR'S REPORT:

As far as the change in the manpower in the Police is concerned, Maybole will definitely have a Sergeant who will cover the whole Ward and while we may not always get the officer of our choice if we contact the Police Office, we will be passed on to an appropriate officer.

Mrs Masterman mentioned that in the previous minutes Councillor Goldie had advised us there was no likelihood of getting 30mph limits between Fisherton and Dunure. She asks if it was not possible to even get street lighting on this stretch of the road.

Mr Storie would like thanks to be passed on to roads department for the repairs attended to between Drumshang and Fisherton. At the same time he advised of a hole needing repaired on Castle Road, also outside 4 Station Road. The latter it was advised had already been reported. Mr Guthrie asked that a waste bin be sited at the Bus Stop on Kennedy Drive. He also confirmed lines have still to be painted in the bus turning area and this has been ongoing now for a few years.

The flooding on Lagg Brae is also a concern and Councillor Goldie will pass this to the appropriate department. Mr Montgomerie is of the opinion that if a pipe was laid under the road at the foot of the cottages this would take some of the water which usually ends up at the foot of the hill.

- i. **SITE FOR BENCH:** Mr Findlay has been in touch with Scottish Water Solutions who asks that he gets estimates to clear this area and they will send a cheque for the amount.
- ii. **LABYRINTH:** The work is going ahead here depending again on the weather and he is hoping to get the school involved in designing a sign for this.
